Alternative Medical

Alternative Medicine

Don't you have a right to try another way? Not according to the American Medical Establishment and Big Pharma. They have certain "Medical Professionals" (not your doctor) that challenge the competition.

The buzz words for fraud come spewing out of their mouths: "Snake Oil Salesman," "Witch Doctors," and "Loonies." Why? The medical science establishment doesn't want competition.

But Don't They Want People to Get Well?

They will claim wellness is their aim. The truth – they're not in business if people aren't sick and dying.

Watch the commercials for many of these new medications advertized on television. Notice when the announcer lowers his voice when listing the side effects. The reason for this is three fold:

- A disclaimer against lawsuits if they happen you've been warned
- Remember that commercial so you can ask your doctor
- Feeding your subconscious a suggestion psychosomatic illness

How can you make yourself sick by hearing someone talk about this? I hear to many people repeating these commercials. The subconscious mind takes in what said by a lower, softer voice. Repeating it in your own voice anchors it.
